# Training Resources

- Chair Victoria Beale
- Instructor Development Course (IDC) with NHI to certify LTAP instructors to teach NHI courses
- Continuing relationships with NTTD (National Transportation Training) and TC3 (Transportation Curriculum Coordination Council) and attend their conferences.
- Coordination with FHWA's Technology Transfer (T2) working group; and sharing results of our "Needs Assessment" for training video development.
- Resource review & update with FHWA.



## JOINT SAFETY WG

- ➤ Bi-monthly meetings featuring webinar presentations on a multitude of Safety topics, for instance: Making Sense of the MAP21
- Promoting safety research projects, like Pavement Widening and the Use of Rumble Strips on Two-Lane Rural Highways (Auburn University).
- ➤ All LTAP/TTAP regions including DOTs, Centers and County agencies have participated in FHWA's Roadway Safety, Data, and/or Safety Management Plans Peer Exchanges.
- Reports are available from each of these regional peer exchanges.



## JOINT SAFETY WG

- ➤ Safety Train-the-Trainer course at the National LTAP/TTAP Conference in addition to three concurrent sessions on:
  - ➤ Enhanced Safety Programs Part 1: How to fund & budget for safety programs such as Safety Circuit Riders;
  - ➤ Enhanced Safety Programs Part 2: Determining activities & creating work plans for enhanced safety activities;
  - ➤ Promoting a greater safety culture through your LTAP/TTAP program.



## JOINT SAFETY WG

#### PARTNERSHIPS WG

- Partnering activities allow NLTAPA to leverage and share resources among organizations with similar goals and objectives.
- ➤ NLTAPA currently maintains 3 national level, formal partnerships with NACE, APWA and AASHTO.
- > A NACE partnership update was provided under separate cover.
- ➤ The APWA partnership is currently being updated with a focus on a grassroots effort with greater committee participation. Following a well-established relationship with AASHTO committees, NLTAPA is communicating with new leadership in their organization, and soliciting a new liaison from our member centers.

- ➤ Help a new LTAP/TTAP personnel are looking for help or information, and be diligent about explaining acronyms to new people.




## Communications WG
